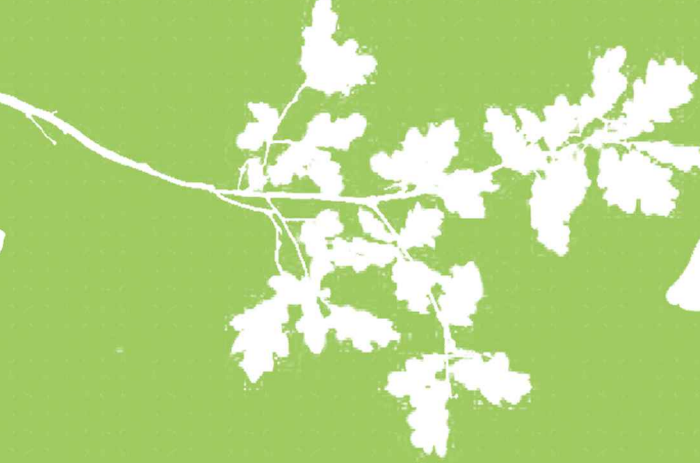
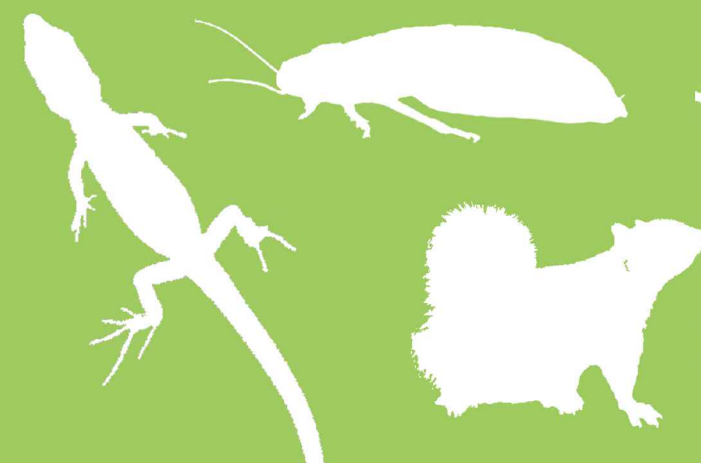
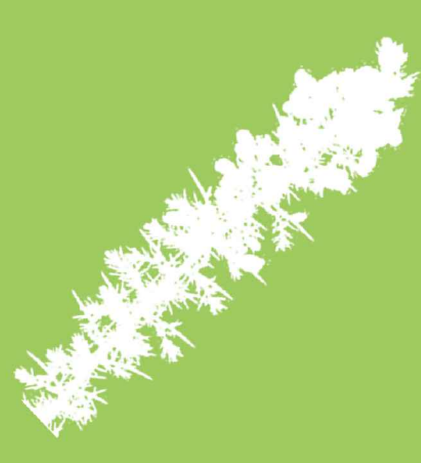

Bats are mammals. There are over 1,000 species of bats in the world but only 9 resident in Ireland.

Irish bats consume insects and they are more common then you think. Bats are nocturnal and are founnd foraging in fields, woods and along watercourses.

Irish bats are very small and most weigh only 5grams! They live in roosts which can be found in small hollows of trees, barns, roofs, churches, and even in your attic!

Bats are a protected species in Ireland and there conservation is important. Tht's why along the Green Ribbon you will notice bat boxes in the trees to provide roosts for the bats. Also, the planting along the Green Ribbon encourages insects to thrive which will help feed the bats!
